- Colorful photographs of Earth's environments, natural resources, and weather events are sure to draw in even the most reluctant readers

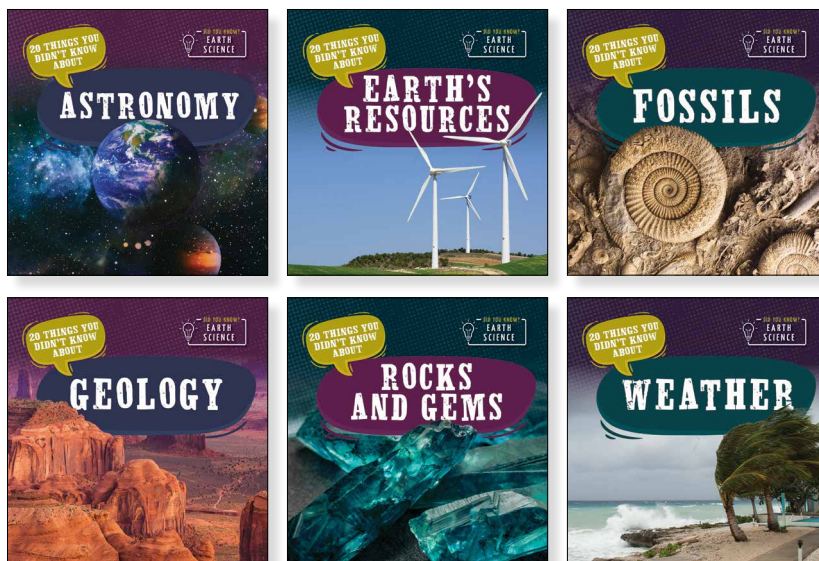

## How Things Grow

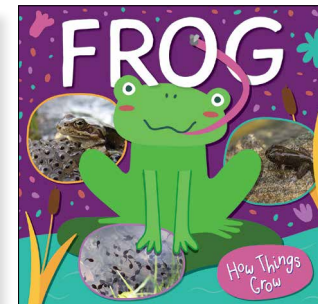
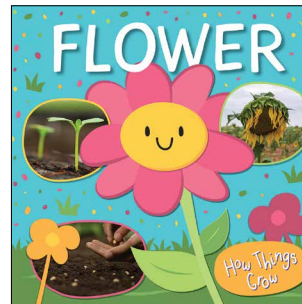
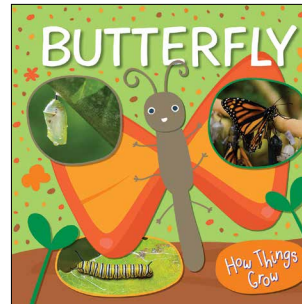
